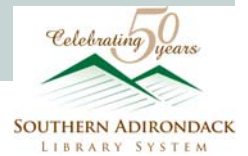

SUMMER READING CLUB

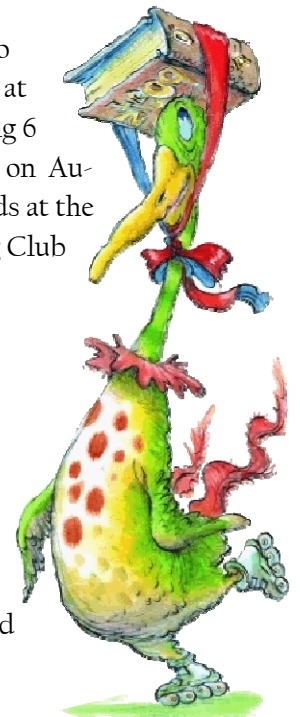
GRADES K—6

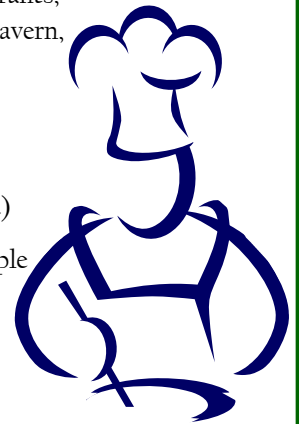

Take a look at these great books for young adults. Because of their quality and timely themes, they're recommended for adult readers, too!

Feed

by M.T. Anderson
Candlewick Press, 2002

In this sci-fi classic, Titus and his friends decide to visit the moon but find it boring. A cautionary tale of the future when a "feed" with computer transmission is directly implanted in people's brains and sends advertising and subliminal messages. When Titus meets Violet, a girl who does not want to be connected, he sees the possibility of free thought, but what about the dangers of going against the crowd?

Monster

by Walter Dean Myers
Harper Collins, 2001

Steve thinks that being a kid in prison is like a movie and he tells the story of his trial in the form of a script. Alone and scared in jail, he thinks about the prosecutor who called him a monster, so that's what he calls his "movie". Did he commit robbery and murder? Will he go to prison for life? This Coretta Scott King Author Award winning book has an original style that makes it easy, but fascinating to read!

Tangerine

by Edward Bloor
Harcourt Books 1997

Paul, 12, and his family move from Houston to Tangerine County, Florida. Paul wants to play soccer but with his thick glasses and poor eyesight his talent is not apparent. Mean older brother Erik, the football star, adds to Paul's problems. And what is the mysterious accident from Paul's past that he can't remember? The suspenseful plot will keep you guessing and rooting for Paul, right up to the finish.

Whale Talk

by Chris Crutcher
Random House, 2001

Taking on the authorities, athletic teen rebel T.J. Jones puts together a swim team from Cutter High's misfits. In this classic tale, the boys bond and grow while they struggle to make it to State Finals and earn the coveted varsity letter jacket. Good characterization and great plot make this a must-read for sports loving teens.

Sloppy Firsts

Jessica's best friend Hope is moving away, her Dad thinks only of her track meets, Mom is obsessed with her sister's wedding, the girls at school give her a hard time, and what about her feelings for Marcus? This novel of teen angst gives a humorous look at the problems teens face from a girl's point of view. Well written, amusing, and right on target!
