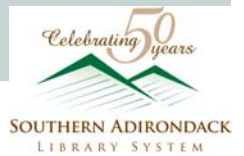


# CHECK IT OUT



## MEET OUR NEW LIBRARY DIRECTOR

We are pleased to announce the appointment of Carol L. Sheffer as our new Library Director.

Sheffer comes to the Round Lake Library after retiring from the Queens Borough Public Library where she served as Deputy Director, managing a 62-branch library system serving 2.2 million residents in the most ethnically-diverse county in the country. Currently, she is president of the Public Library Association, which serves over 12,000 public library staff and trustees as a division of the American Library Association. Sheffer earned a BA in History from SUNY Geneseo and her MLS from the University of Buffalo.

Sheffer finds both the size and the challenges of the much smaller Round Lake Library appealing, particularly with the opportunity to open a new branch for a growing community such as Malta. Sheffer, a resident of North Troy, will work closely with the Round Lake Library Board of Trustees, the Women of Round Lake Improvement Society (WRLIS) and the Town of Malta to open the Malta Community Center branch of the Round Lake Library, scheduled for completion in early fall.

Sandra Debus, president of the Library Board of Trustees, believes Sheffer's experience in library management, children's library services and connections to the greater library community will be beneficial to the growing Town of Malta. "Sheffer is the right director at the right time. She has vision, experience, and a passion for libraries."
