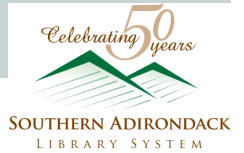

## THE THOUSAND BOOK KID PROGRAM

### Literacy Program Now Available at Both Library Branches

We are pleased to announce that we are partnering with the Malta Sunrise Rotary to extend this great reading program to both locations of the Round Lake Library.

The 1000 Book Kid Program is a free reading program aimed at Malta preschoolers. It is a user-friendly way for busy parents or caregivers to borrow quality, age-appropriate books for their preschool children.

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. Sign up at the Round Lake Library's Clark House or Malta Branch and fill out a blue card.
2. Select and check out 10 children's books.
3. When checking out, inform the library staff that this is a 1000 Book Kid. The 10 books will be placed in a special bag provided by the Malta Sunrise Rotary.
4. When you return your books and book bag, circle the next number on your child's card.

Then start the process over again!

When you have circled 100 numbers on the card, your child will have read 1000 books— and be awarded a certificate and a special sweatshirt courtesy of the Malta Sunrise Rotary.

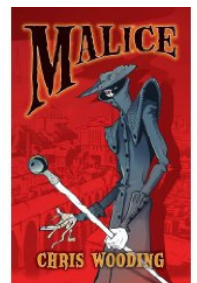

## NEW BOOK REVIEW: SIGNING THEIR LIVES AWAY

by Denise Kiernan and Joseph D'Agnese. Quirk Books, 2009.

A quirky, sometimes irreverent look at the 56 men who risked their lives and fortunes by signing the Declaration Of Independence. While we know about some of the signers, such as Jefferson, Adams and Franklin, we may not know that William Floyd and Francis Lewis are more than street names on Long Island, or that actress Reese Witherspoon is a direct descendant of one of the signers. An engaging book that includes the Declaration itself, as well as a timeline, bibliography and a detailed index.

### REUNION AND REMEMBRANCE DISCUSSION AND BOOK SIGNING

Please join us on Thursday, April 10 at 6:30pm at the Malta Branch for a discussion, reading, and book signing with Carl Eeman, author of *Encampment: A Novel of Race and Reconciliation*.
