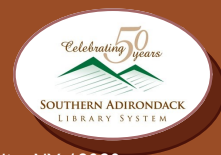

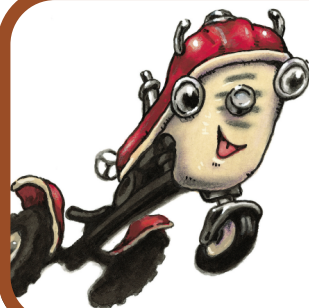
Read For the Record

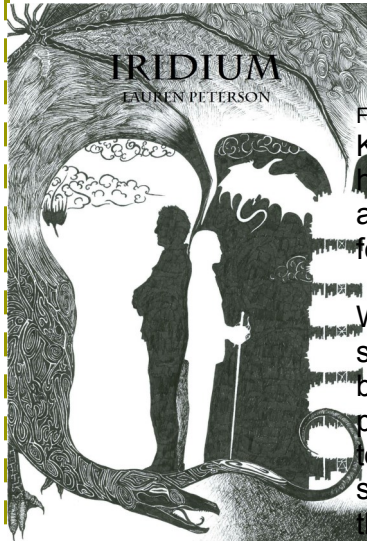

Author Talks, Readings & Book Signings



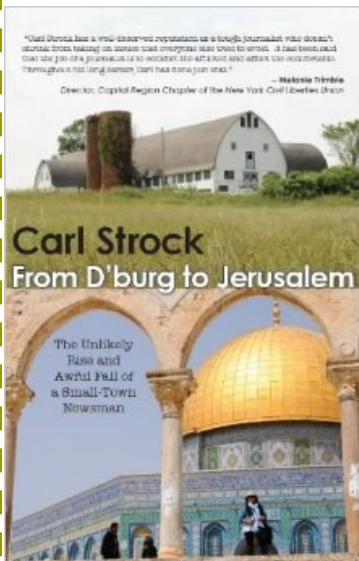
Local Author from Round Lake will present her new work, *Iridium*.

With the reluctant aid of a prickly white archaeology professor, Elwen finds himself involved in a case that has far greater ramifications than delving into an illegal antiquities market and solving a murder, but will challenge the societal structure of Kellermark itself.

Carl Strock will be giving a book talk for his recent release, *"From D'burg to Jerusalem"*.

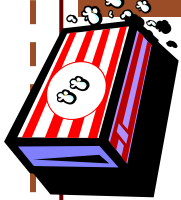

From D'burg to Jerusalem chronicles the author's journalistic adventures from the most trivial - the painting of the town garage roof in Duanesburg - to the most far-reaching - religious nationalism in Jerusalem, visiting along the way police corruption, the power of teachers' unions, the sexual abuse (or non-abuse) of children, Christian fundamentalism, and more. These are the stories that Carl Strock explored in his newspaper column, brought together for the first time, with a trajectory that goes up and up - until it suddenly goes down.

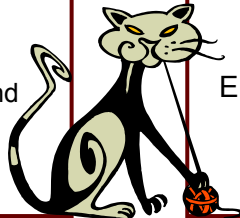

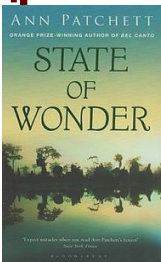

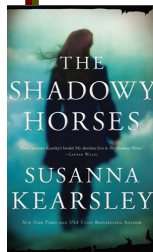
