


## DOWNTON ABBEY WITHDRAWAL? E CAN HELP

Lady Almina and the Real Downton Abbey, written by Fiona Aitken, the eighth Countess of Carnarvon, explores the history of Highclere, the filming location and partial inspiration of the series, and the members of the British aristocracy who have called it home over the past century and a half.



Downton Abbey creator Julian Fellowes' New York Times bestselling book Snobs is a modern comedic and satiric stab at the upper crust of British society.

If you missed this year's Oscar event, plan to join us next year at the Second Annual Oscar Night at the Library.




