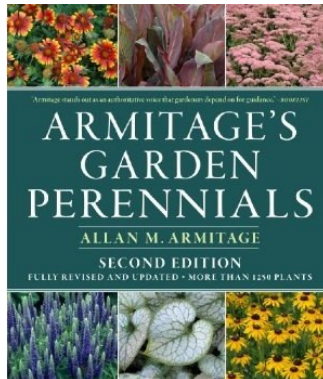

Armitage's Garden Perennials: Second Edition, Fully revised and Updated by A.M. Armitage. Armitage is a noted authority on plants.

Planting the Dry Shade Garden: The Best Plants for the Toughest Spot in your Garden by Graham Rice, will help those with lots of shade make the most of their space.

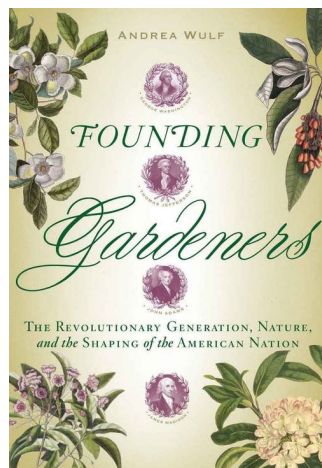
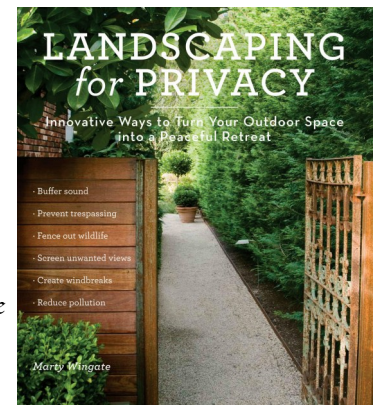
