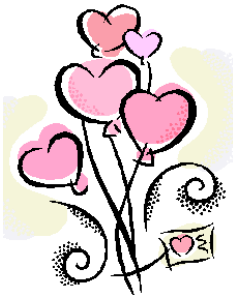

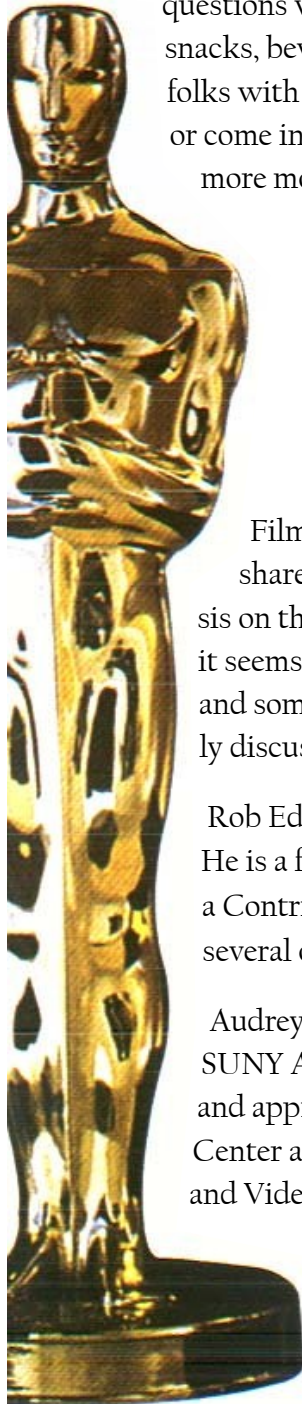

The Politics of Oscar

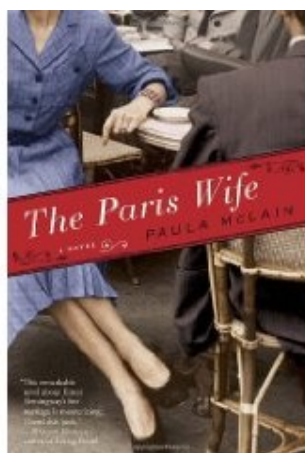

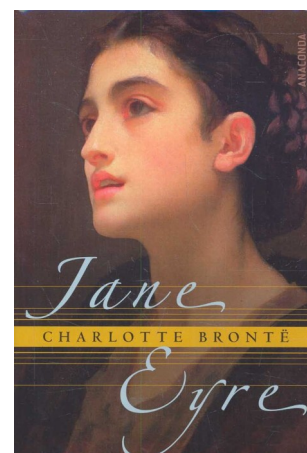

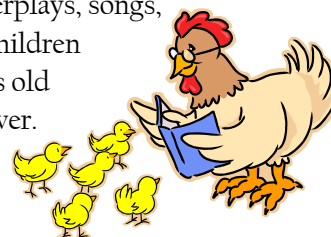
