March 2022

March was a much busier month than February. Both door counts and circulation numbers increased for the month. With the increased door counts and returning programs it is starting to feel a bit more normal.

On February 23, 2022 SALS/JA implemented a new self-registration. This allows patrons to register for a library card online and receive a digital barcode that is good for 60 days; which can then be exchanged at the library for a physical library card. Since turning this feature on the Round Lake Library has 6 online registrations and 1 exchange for a physical card.

The library did a soft launch of Hoopla (digital platform) on March 23, 2022. In the eight days it was active for March there were 9 patron logins and 12 circulations. The library is planning on doing a full launch and marketing campaign starting in May 2022.

The library director and assistant director attended the Public Library Association Conference in Portland, Oregon. This 3 day conference is held every 2 years and offers many opportunities to attend programs on library related issues, network with colleagues and speak with vendors about library supplies and various material.

Albany Fire Extinguisher preformed their annual inspection of the fire extinguishers at Clark House. Two of the four extinguishers are no longer serviceable and expired. They have ordered two new ones and will install when they are delivered.

The Malta Community Center has a new Acting Director, Kristan Gottman. She has been in to meet some of the library staff and we look forward to working with her.

In the Malta Branch, the town maintenance crew are working to switch over the exhibiting light bulbs to LED bulbs. Bulbs were ordered over a month ago and have arrived and are being switched over the next week. The maintenance crew is also working to repair a spot in the wall located in the back workroom where a leak occurred a few months prior. The town is also looking into replacing the existing phone system at the community center, which would include the library. We were notified by the Town Comptroller that this is being discussed but the process could take a while to be implemented.
