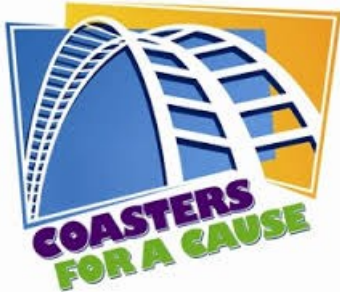

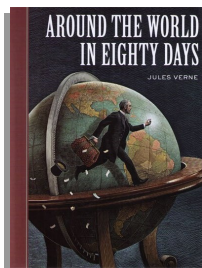

TUESDAY NIGHT BOOK CLUB

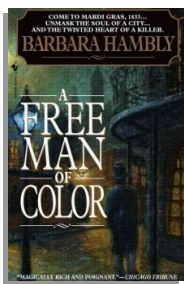


This month we will be discussing the classic travel adventure, *Around the World in Eighty Days* by Jules Verne.

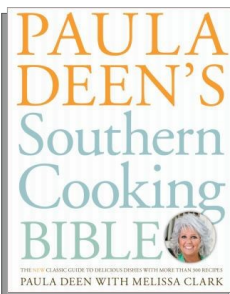

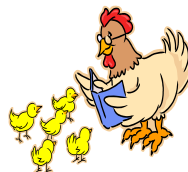

Story time introduces young children to books, music & other fun activities. Our story time includes the early literacy skills that children must master before they can learn to read.



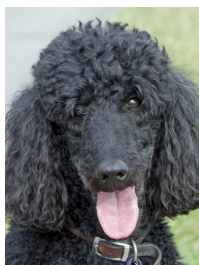

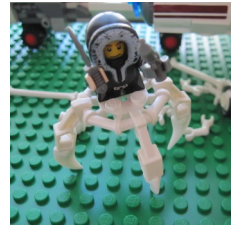

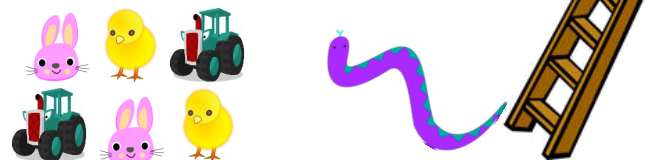
