We've missed you all during quarantine and closure, and hope you are all healthy and faring well. We are doing everything we can to assure the safety of our patrons and staff as we gradually reopen and reinstate services.

At this time and through at least July 13th, we are offering curbside pickup of held items only. See our website for the latest details on placing holds and curbside pickup, or call us to find out how it works and to place items on hold.

All library item returns should be placed in the outside book drops. We are currently quarantining items for at least 3 days before checking them in, so returns will not be reflected your account after that time has elapsed. We are not charging overdue fees, nor accepting payment of fines and fees at this time.

We are not currently offering computer use (although our wifi is always on and reaches outside our walls), nor any printing, faxing, copying or scanning services, but are assessing ways to safely offer these service in future phases of our reopening.


Summer Cosplay Contest
