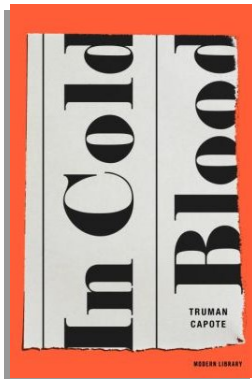

This month we will be discussing *In Cold Blood: A True Account of Multiple Murder and Its Consequences* by Truman Capote.

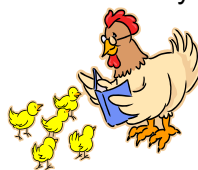

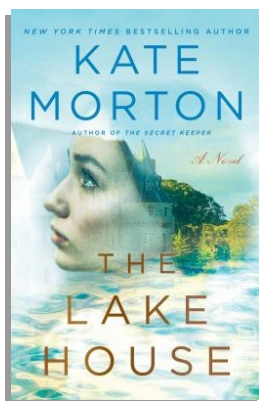
Story time introduces young children to books, music & other fun activities. Our story time includes the early literacy skills that children must master before they can learn to read.

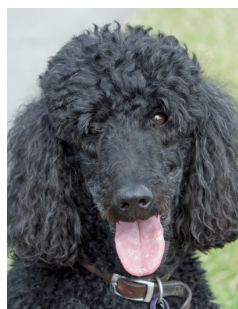

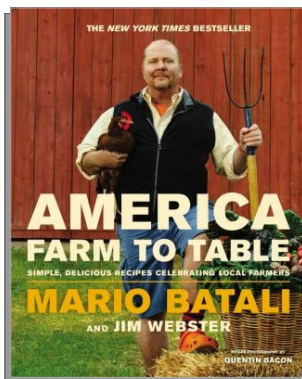

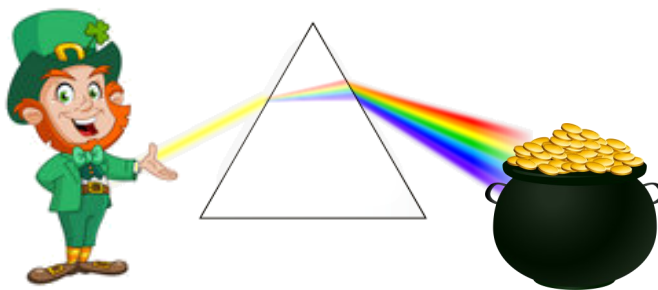

DECORATING EGGS FOR KIDS

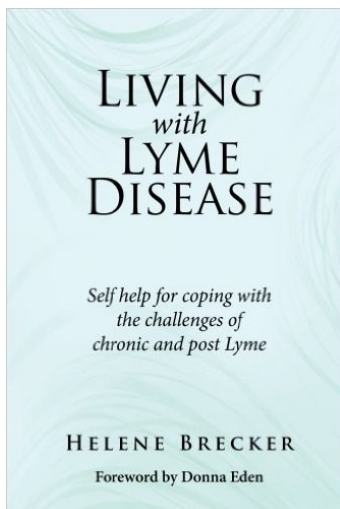
