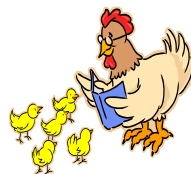

Story Time introduces young children to books, music & other fun activities. Our story time includes the early literacy skills that children must master before they can learn to read.



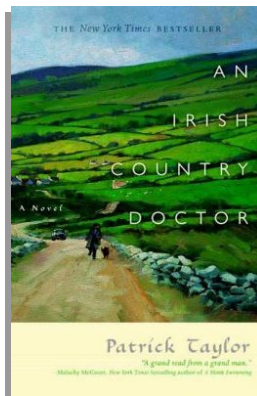
