Banned Books Week is an annual event that draws attention to the harms of censorship. It is a celebration of the freedom to read, to seek and express ideas, even those some consider unorthodox or unpopular.

Even today, there are still efforts to remove or restrict access to books. Books featured in our library displays were targeted with restriction or removal from libraries or schools. By maintaining access to these materials, we hope to facilitate an open dialog about the issues and controversies that some wish to censor, and let people make their own choices.

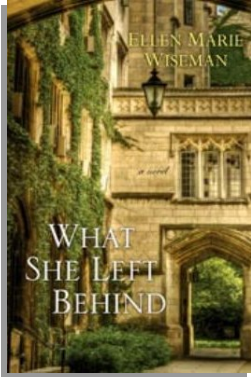

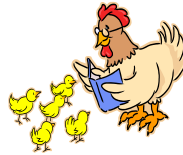

Story Time introduces young children to books, music & other fun activities. Our story time includes the early literacy skills that children must master before they can learn to read.



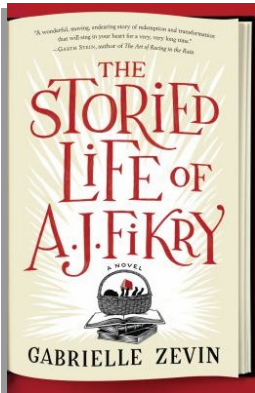

Well-written scenes are one of the tools writers use to create dynamic fiction. A scene is a unit of drama with its own structure and requirements. In this three-session workshop, we will explore the scene's role in moving a story forward using action, dialog, and specific settings. You do not need to have writing experience or a work-in-progress to attend this workshop. But you just might find a story emerging from the new scenes you'll create in this supportive class.



After the first three sessions, we will continue for another three sessions to apply our scene-writing skills to memoir writing.
