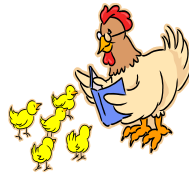

Story time introduces young children to books, music & other fun activities. Our story time includes the early literacy skills that children must master before they can learn to read.



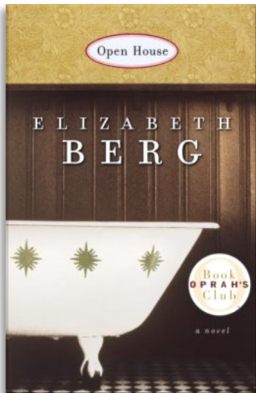

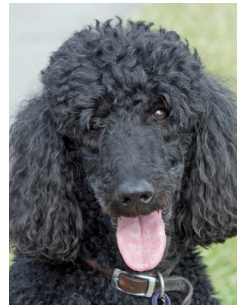


Join us to discuss *Open House* by Elizabeth Berg, the story of a newly divorced woman who opens her house to boarders in order to keep it.

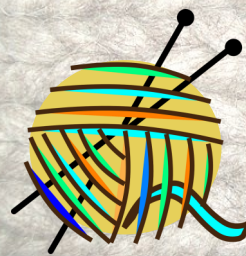

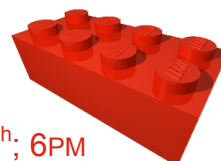

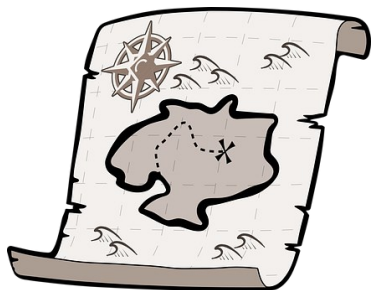
