

We would like to thank all of our patrons for their patience and understanding during this pandemic. The Round Lake Library is now ready to move fully into stage three of our reopening plan. While patrons have been allowed into the library to pick up material at the circulation desk browsing has not been allowed. We are excited to announce that on Wednesday, August 12th, patrons will be allowed to browse the library stacks. As we move forward with our reopening plan there are some rules and restrictions that must be followed.

All patrons must wear a mask or face covering (must cover nose and mouth) upon entering the library and the mask/face covering must remain on during the entire visit. Patrons and staff must also adhere to social distancing guidelines and remain at least 6 feet apart when possible. We also need to limit the number of patrons in the library due to social distancing requirements.

While patrons will be able to browse the library shelves, tables and seating will not be available at this time. Access to our public computers will not be available at this time. Copying and scanning services will be available; please see a staff member for assistance.

Curbside service will also be available during operating hours (10 am – 6 pm). Please call the library when you arrive and we will bring your items out to you.
